3,200 sheets each yr.²

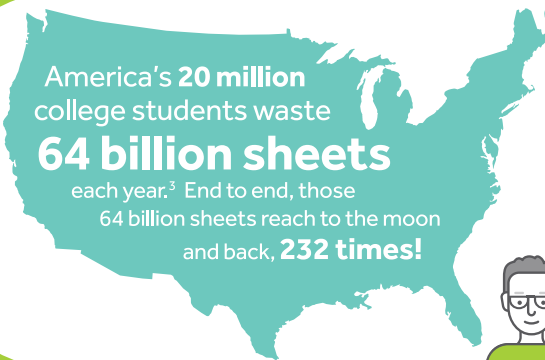
That's 1/3 of a tree per student (or one slightly overweight 320lb panda)
